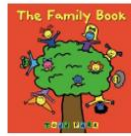


Super Reads



Communication and Language

We will...

- Use our chatterboxes to talk about our interests and our families.
- Begin to ask and answer questions.
- Join in with circle times and begin to share our ideas in small groups.
- Practice following instructions.
- Begin to talk to our peers and adults about our learning.

Personal, Social and Emotional Development

We will...

- Begin to understand our feelings – happy, sad, angry, worried.
- Practice putting our coat on and off.
- Manage our own personal hygiene such as washing hands and going to the toilet independently.
- Build new friendships and relationships with peers and adults.

Physical Development

We will...

- Develop our strength and balance by using the outdoor play equipment.
- Using tools such as tweezers to develop our hand and finger strength.
- Develop our finger strength in preparation for writing with a pen/ pencil.

Literacy

We will...

- Children will begin learning the initial code, starting their phonics journey. The sounds we will learn this term are; **a, i, m, s, t, n, o, p, b, c, g, h.**
- Children will begin to use and learn core blending, segmenting and manipulation skills.
- Use mark making to express our ideas.
- Practice writing the letters in our own name.
- Engage in story times and talk about their favourite books.

Mathematics

We will...

- Subitise (identify an amount without counting) within 3.
- Focus on our counting skills, counting beyond 10.
- Compare quantities of objects using the words 'more than and fewer than'.
- Explore how numbers are made of 1s.
- Explore how 3 and 4 are made.

Understanding the World

We will...

- Look at family photos from the past and notice how we have changed.
- Explore our natural world and talk about Autumn.
- Learn who God is and listen to a story from the bible.
- Visit the school grounds to look for features of the school environment.

Expressive Arts and Design

We will...

- Learn the primary colours practice colour mixing.
- Use different tools to make marks and create our own self-portraits.
- Create different patterns and textures using different tools.
- Listen and sing to a variety of songs and nursery rhymes.
